MULTIPLICATION FACT FLUENCY

- 3rd Grade standard to fluently know facts 1-10.
- Fluency that leads to memorization
 - Understanding, accuracy, efficiency
 Most important= can find answer on own
- Commutative Property & Fact Families If you know one fact- you know two facts and if you know two facts - you know four facts. Ex. If I know $6 \times 7 = 42....$ Then I know $7 \times 6 = 42....$ I also know $42 \div 6 = 7$ and $42 \div 7 = 6$.

• Distributive Property: Use a known fact to help! <u>How to help at home:</u>

- Practice a few min a night
- Be creative: card games, in the car, online
- Use resources given in BTSN folder
